## Ephesians 6:10-20 (NIV and The Message)


**Summary:** This piece has a serious message but it is delivered in a humorous way. It urges us to put on the full armor of God in prayer in order to stop the enemy and keep each other strong.

**Actor Requirements:** Minimum of four actors, no maximum. No gender requirements. Lines can be broken up differently depending on the number of actors you choose to work with.

**Characters:** Number 1 is the drill sergeant and is to take on the stereo-typical vocalizations and movements of a drill sergeant. 2, 3, and 4 are soldiers who stand tall and strong and keep their eyes straight ahead at all times.

**Note:** The blocking is just a suggestion and not a requirement. Feel free to change the blocking completely to suit your needs.

March onto stage from stage left in a line (2, 3, 4, then 1). 1 will land slightly downstage of 2-4.



The text before "Ephesians 6:10–20. NIV and..." is an optional marching call and answer cadence between the drill sergeant and the soldiers to get the group on and off stage.

- 1: Left, left, right, left.
